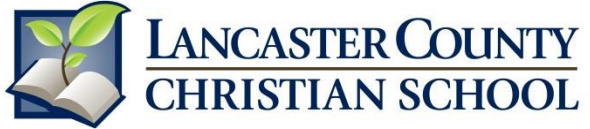


## State Mandated Exams/Records 2017-2018



The state mandates that current immunization records, physical exams, and dental exams be submitted on or before the first day of school for students **entering** the following grades:

- **Kindergarten** – immunization records, physical exam, dental exam
- **3<sup>rd</sup> Grade** – dental exam
- **6<sup>th</sup> Grade** – physical exam (A recent sport physical is acceptable.)
- **7<sup>th</sup> Grade** – dental exam, 1 dose Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine (MCV4), and if 5 years have elapsed since last Tetanus immunization 1 dose of Tetanus, Diphtheria, Acellular Pertussis (Tdap)
- **11<sup>th</sup> Grade** – physical exam (A recent sport physical is acceptable.)
- **All Grades** must have 2 doses of Varicella vaccine (Chickenpox) or history of disease and date

If your student is coming to LCCS from being homeschooled, you will be required to submit current immunization records and physical and dental exams regardless of the grade being entered.

Because some insurance plans may limit the frequency of covered physicals/dental exams, we recognize that you may need to schedule an appointment after the first day of school in order for it to be covered. If your physical/dental exam is scheduled after the first day of school, please advise the school with the scheduled date. If it is not possible to complete all immunizations within the five-day period due to spacing or other medical reasons, families must present a medical plan completed by their family practitioner indicating dates for completion of each immunization series

### **Immunization Records**

#### **Children in all grades K to 12 need the following immunization for attendance:**

- 4 doses of tetanus, diphtheria and acellular pertussis (DTaP or DTP or DT or Td)(1 dose on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
- 4 doses of polio (1 dose on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday and at least 6 months after previous dose)
- 2 doses of measles, mumps and rubella, given as MMR
- 3 doses of hepatitis B (properly spaced)
- 2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) or evidence of immunity or date of disease

#### **Children in grades 7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup>, the additional immunizations are required for attendance:**

- 2 doses of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV)
  - 1<sup>st</sup> dose given 11 to 15 years old and/or prior to the start of 7<sup>th</sup> grade
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> dose given 16 years or older and/or prior to the start of 12<sup>th</sup> grade
- 1 dose of tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (tdap)
  - 1 dose given prior to the start of 7<sup>th</sup> grade

If your child is missing any of these required immunizations, they will be placed on provisional status and will have 5 school days to comply. After the 5th day, he or she will be excluded from school until the vaccinations are received and the information delivered to the school.

**Leola campus Physical & Dental Exams**

For students attending the Leola campus, physical and dental exams must be completed by your family doctor/dentist.

**West Lampeter campus Physical & Dental Exams**

For students attending the West Lampeter campus, physical and dental exams may be done by your family doctor/dentist or by the Lampeter-Strasburg doctor/dentist. Please note that if you choose to use the L-S dentist, it is only a screening. The L-S medical exam will be done on a Saturday, and you must provide your own transportation. The L-S dental screening takes place on a Tuesday or Thursday in January or February. Please complete the form below if you wish to take advantage of the L-S physical/dental services and return it on or by the first day of school. If you choose to use your own family doctor/dentist, it will be your responsibility to have this mandated exam at your expense.

All documents may be mailed, faxed, or hand delivered to the campus the student will be attending. If you have any questions or concerns regarding this information, please feel free to contact us. We appreciate your attention to these required documents.
